Although Snow White was the first full length animated cartoon to be produced in Technicolor it was not the first full length cartoon, there had been 6 before it and the 1917 Argentine film 'El Apóstol' holds the distinction of being the first. It was however the first to become so successful and has remained the jewel in Disney's crown for nearly 85 years.

The plot of the film, adapted from the old German fairy tale Snow White by the Brothers Grimm, explores the story of a jealous and wicked queen's attempts to have her stepdaughter murdered. She escapes and is given shelter by seven dwarfs (these are some of the screens most memorable characters), who live deep in a forest, but the evil queen discovers her hiding place and renews her murderous plots. Snow White is as fresh today as when it was first released in 1938, and was the most successful motion picture of the year. It's also the third highestgrossing film of all time within the United States when adjusted for infla-

Based on the 1923 book 'Bambi, A Life in the Woods' by Austrian author Felix Salten, this film released in 1942 follows the growing pains of a young fawn, discovering and learning about the world around him, both its beauty and its danger.
